

Cost Breakdown Estimates for Students (non-Ashesi)

Ashesi Health & Care Initiative (AHCI) In-Person Courses for Africa Health

Below is a cost breakdown showing various ranges and cost options for non-Ashesi students who want to enroll in the in-person 6-week Courses under AHCI.

Option 1:

If the student chooses to stay in the halls on campus the cost for a room (that can have 2 or 4 students) will be approximately the equivalent in cedis of \$500.

6-week accommodation	<i>Please see Table 1.0 and 2.0 below for options 2 and 3</i>	Lower-cost options are located in the Berekuso township; however, staying there will require arranging transportation to and from campus. You can explore this list of Ashesi-approved off-campus hostels , which includes details on amenities, utility subsidies, and proximity to campus. Please note that lower-cost options tend to sell out quickly, so early arrangements are recommended.
6-week meals per day	GHS90.00 – GHS120.00/day	Meals on campus cost on average GHS30.00 a plate, while meals in Berekuso cost on average GHS40.00 a meal.
6-week transportation expense*	GHS400.00/week minimum to and from Berekuso to campus.	This will be necessary is students who resort to staying in Berekuso. Some off-campus hostels here have transport arrangements to and from campus.
Miscellaneous i.e., healthcare, laundry, other items**	GHS500.00	

*-This is an optional expense only for students who choose to stay in the Berekuso Township and need transport to and from campus.

** - Amenities including laundry and cleaning services, etc. are available at a fee. Several clinics & hospitals are available in the area, along with the on-campus [Natembea Health Centre](#), which

provides a wide range of services, including lab testing. The university strongly advises all students to obtain health insurance to cover referrals. Single Room	GHS 4,900.00 – GHS 5,600.00 Full semester cost is GHS 10,500.00 – GHS 12,000.00	Amenities include standby generators, security services, janitorial support, parking, electricity, Wi-Fi, and water. The rooms are spacious and self-contained. However, some accommodations restrict cooking in the in-room kitchenette, requiring residents to use a central kitchen instead. Prospective tenants are advised to confirm specific accommodation requirements directly with the respective landlords.
2 in a Room	GHS 2,520.00 – GHS 4,200.00 Full semester cost is GHS5,400.00 – GHS9,000.00	
3 in a room	GHS 1,680.00 – GHS 3,100.00 Full semester cost is GHS3,600.00 – GHS6,500.00	Amenities include standby generators, security services, janitorial support, parking, electricity, Wi-Fi, and water. The rooms are spacious and self-contained. However, some accommodations restrict cooking in the in-room kitchenette, requiring residents to use a central kitchen instead. Prospective tenants are advised to confirm specific accommodation requirements directly with the respective landlords.
4 in a room	GHS 1,200.00 – GHS 1,700.00 Full semester cost is GHS2,600.00 – GHS3,500.00	Amenities include standby generators, security services, janitorial support, parking, electricity, Wi-Fi, and water. In some three-person rooms, there are two washrooms and a kitchenette for preparing meals. However, in other accommodations, residents

		are required to use a central kitchen instead. Prospective tenants are advised to confirm specific accommodation requirements directly with the respective landlords.

Accommodation off the Hill i.e., in the Berekuso Township

Room	Cost Range (min – max)	Comments
Single room	GHS 140.00 – GHS 1,900.00 Full semester cost is GHS300.00– GHS4,000.00	Accommodation options range from self-contained units to those with shared facilities, such as washrooms and kitchens. Some rental agreements include utilities, while others require separate payments. Amenities like air conditioning and transportation to campus vary depending on the property.
2 in a room	Accommodation in Berekuso primarily consists of single-room units, with options for 2, 3, or 4 rooms being relatively uncommon. Participants who prefer shared room spaces are advised to coordinate directly with the respective landlords to make suitable arrangements.
